HOW LONG IS THE SHOW?

WHERE DO I GO TO GET TICKETS?

All patrons must check in at the **Mobile Box Office** located between the center café and the Winspear Opera House to pick up their tickets. There is **NO LATE seating**, so please arrive 15 minutes before curtain. And don't forget your headphones!
